ITMO definition

Be measured in metric tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO2e) in accordance with the methodologies and common metrics assessed by the IPCC and adopted by the CMA and/or in other metrics [determined by the participating Parties] [consistent with the (national determined contributions (NDCs) of the participating Parties];
