As part of the European Green Deal, implementation of a BCA is once again being considered as a measure to address competitiveness concerns within the EU. According to the roadmap for the European Green Deal, and European Council conclusions from July, a proposal for a BCA for “selected sectors” will be released in 2021 and should be introduced by the end of 2022.

ERCST is examining the various available policy design elements and options, along with the associated environmental, economic, political and legal implications, in order to better understand what form of BCA might work for the EU.

This session will build on earlier stakeholder meetings and discussions on i.a. the [Inception Impact Assessment](#), focusing on stakeholders’ **initial reactions and positions to the European Commission’s Public Consultations** which is taking place until October, 28.
