- 7 countries (PL, RO, EE, BU, HU, SL, CZ)
- Ongoing participation and monitoring
- Regular briefings (www.bankwatch.org)



Preparation of the TJTPs: who is in charge?

- Varies depending on the country:
 - national-level authorities, i.e. ministry-led steering committees (CZ, EE)
 - national and regional authorities (PL, HU, RO, SL)
 - unclear (BU)



Preparation of TJTPs: current state in CEE

- TJTPs for CEE prepared:
 - PL 7, EE 1, HU 3, SL 3, BU 3, CZ - 3, RO - 6
- Process of submission to EC and negotiations on ammendments – approval mid-2022
- Payment of Just Transition Funds dependent on negotiations concerning the Partnership Agreement
- Expected payment of funds probably no earlier than Autumn 2022 for CEE



What is working?

- The TJTPs exist 🙂
- Slowly rising ambitions and setting of coal phase-out dates
- Good participatory processes and transparency (patchy)
- A real debate on climate change and transitioning
- Increased amount of participants
- Maintained relatively high interest



What isn't working?

- Low ambitions
- Insufficient diagnoses and strategies
- Intransparency and low participation
- Circumventing limitations on fossil fuel funding
- Greenwashing
- Privileged positions of some stakeholders
- Low capacity
- Lack of gender-related analyses and strategies
