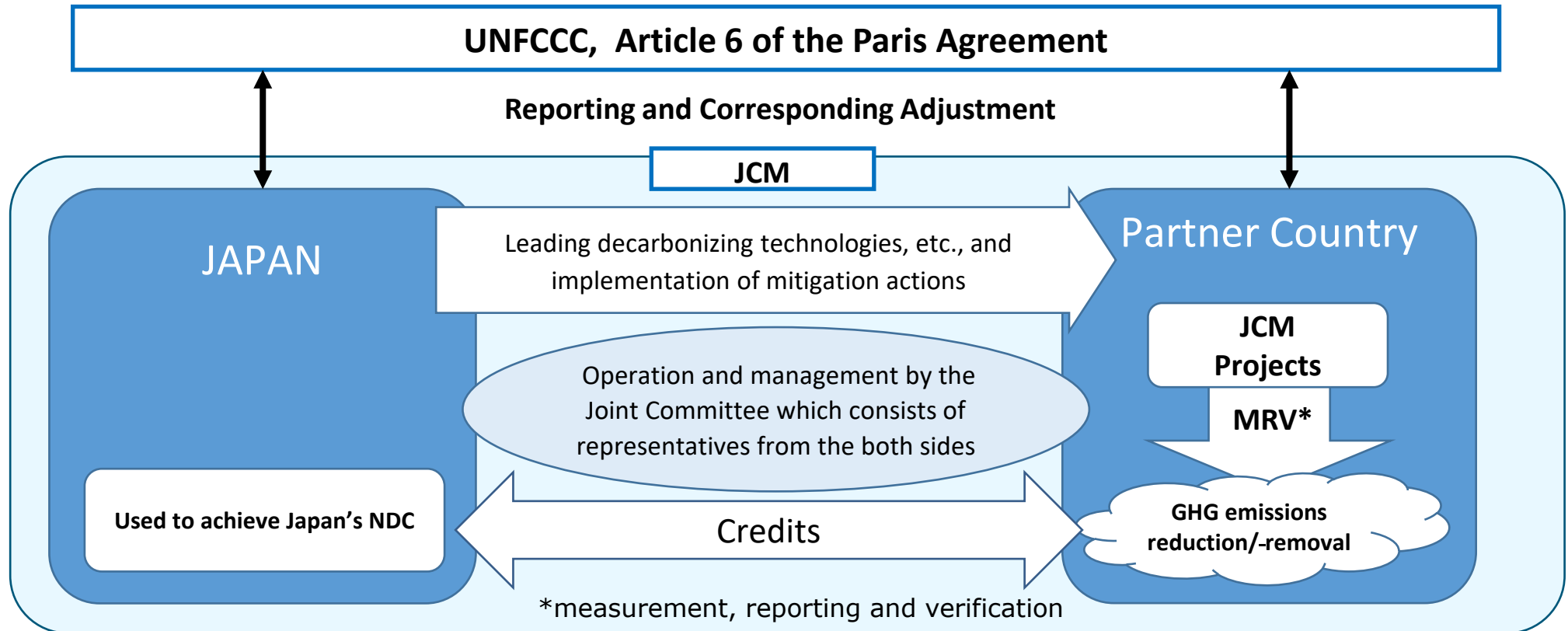
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Basic concept of the JCM and contribution to carbon neutrality



- Contribute to the achievement of both countries' NDCs while ensuring the avoidance of double counting through corresponding adjustments.
- Implement the JCM consistent with the guidance on cooperative approaches, referred to in Article 6, paragraph 2 of the Paris Agreement.

Project Cycle of the JCM

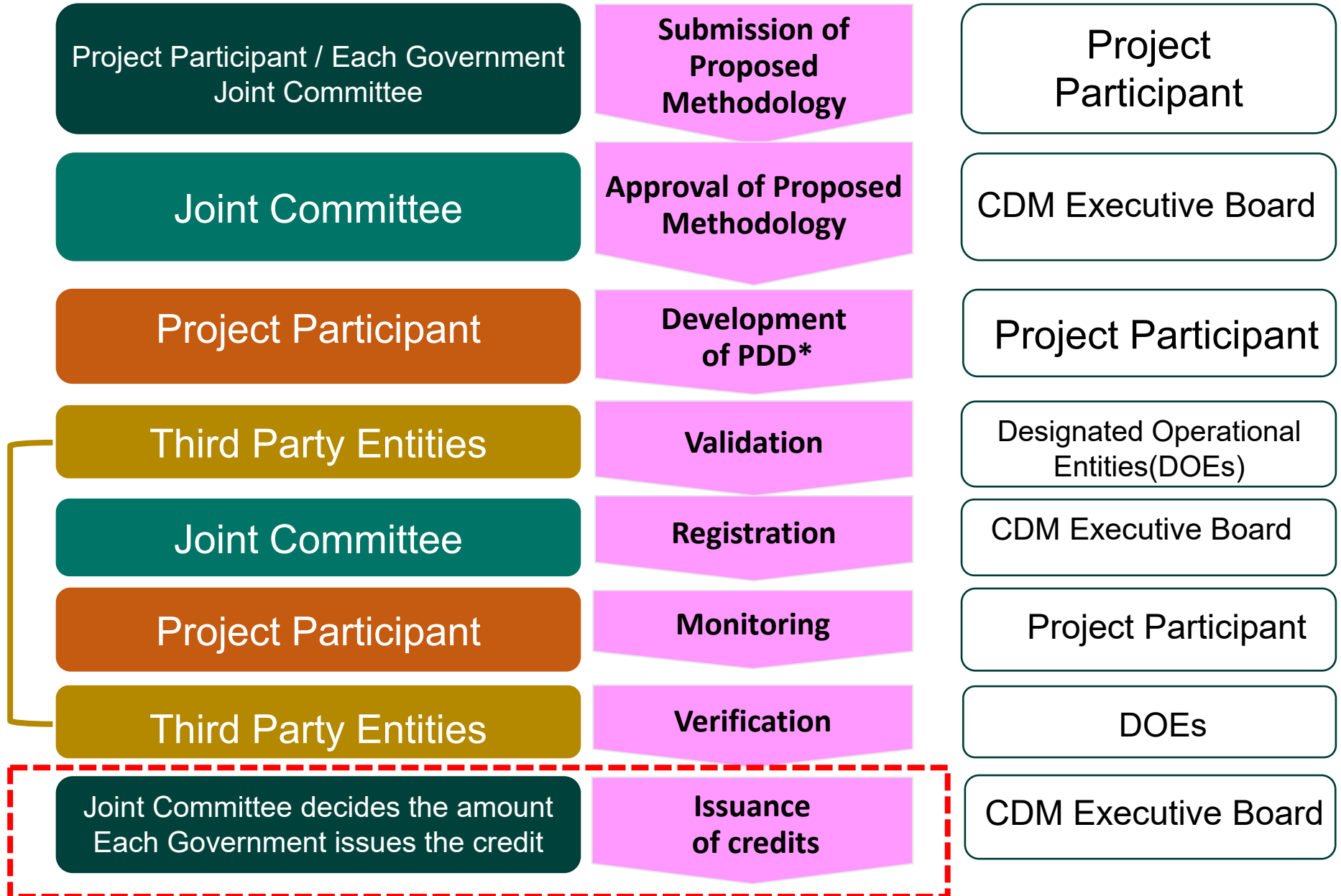


Can be conducted by the same TPE

Implementation of the Article 6 rules into domestic rules

- **JCM Promotion and Utilization Council** was established in January 2022, which consists of relevant 5 Ministries (MoEJ, Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, and Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism)

Chapter 3 Countermeasures and policy measures to achieve targets

In addition, for the implementation of the JCM in Japan in line with the Paris Agreement and the related decisions, as well as the bilateral documents for the JCM and the rules and guidelines adopted by the Joint Council established based on the said documents, the JCM Promotion and Utilization Council is established in the JCM implementing authorities.

- The Council's duties include :
 1. the authorization of JCM credits as a Party to the Paris Agreement,
 2. the determination of a method to apply a corresponding adjustment to prevent double counting,
 3. the revision of the Guidelines for the Implementation of the JCM in Japan.

Procedures for Authorization by Japan as a Party to the Paris Agreement regarding the Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) (Summary)

Procedures on the authorization and its corresponding adjustment

- public consultation :Feb.4th to March 5th ,2022
- Adopted on April 7th 2022 by the JCM Promotion and Utilization Council

Who authorize:

- The JCM Promotion and Utilization Council (in Japan)

What to authorize:

- **JCM credits** issued in the JCM registry of Japan,
- **JCM projects** issuing those JCM credits
- **Legal entities acquiring those JCM credits**, etc., based on the notification from the Joint Committees decided in line with the JCM bilateral documents, rules and guidelines.

Procedures for Authorization by Japan as a Party to the Paris Agreement regarding the Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) (Summary)

Information publicly available:

- The JCM implementing authorities **promptly publish the information on authorization on the JCM website**
- The name of a relevant **partner country**, the name of a **JCM project**, the name of a **legal entity** acquiring JCM credits, **JCM credit identification number**, and **the status of authorization** by the relevant partner country, etc.

Basic Concept of the JCM

The Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) facilitates diffusion of leading decarbonizing technologies, products, systems, services, and infrastructure as well as implementation of mitigation actions, and contributes to sustainable development of partner countries. It appropriately evaluates contributions from Japan to GHG emission reductions or removals in a quantitative manner, and Japan uses them to achieve its NDC.

The JCM contributes to the ultimate objective of the UNFCCC by facilitating global actions for GHG emission reductions or removals.
