Participants in the CCUS Forum in Oslo, hosted on 27-28 October, discussed several issues related to a strategic vision for CCUS, CO₂ infrastructure, and CCUS industrial partnership.

The Forum endorsed two documents prepared by the working groups on the CCUS Vision Strategy and CO₂ Infrastructure. However, the industrial partnership concept still requires further reflection. Stakeholders agreed that a CCUS industrial partnership will be needed to speed up the deployment of those technologies to achieve climate neutrality, but the discussion over the format of such cooperation must continue.
